He became a Member of Parliament in 2004 and served as Minister of Administrative Reform and e-Governance from 2013 to 2015. Prior to his career in politics, he spent a decade in the private sector as CEO of NBG Venture Capital (part of the National Bank of Greece), Financial Analyst with Chase Investment Bank, Consultant with McKinsey & Company, and Senior Investment Officer with Alpha Ventures.
